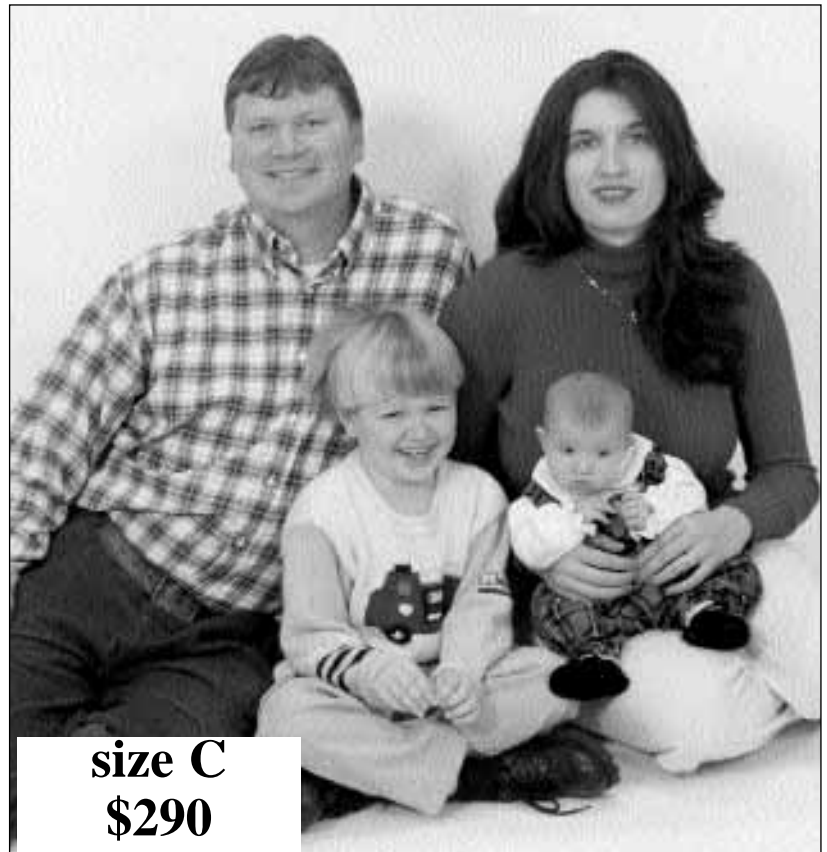

* To have your photo mailed back to you, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your form and payment.

counter on Marshall Street within 30 days after publication.
