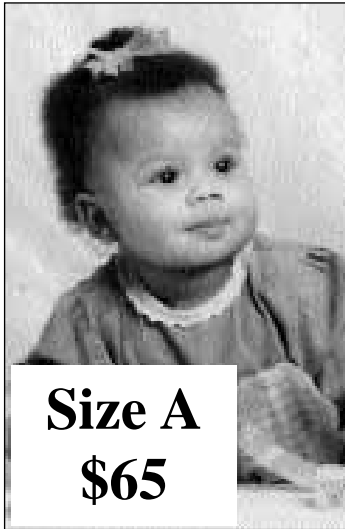

♥ **PHOTO REQUIREMENTS:**

– 5 x 7 black and white, professional glossy print works best for reproduction. For digital photos, a 5 x 7 image at 200 dpi (minimum) is required.

– The photo's VERTICAL DIMENSION must be longest.

– Please put your name on the back.

The *Winston-Salem Journal* reserves the right to refuse for publication photos that are deemed poor quality.

Photos may be picked up at the front counter on Marshall Street within 30 days after publication. To have your photo mailed back to you, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your announcement and payment.

♥ If you have questions, call the Celebrations Editor at 336-727-7422. Mail the completed form to the *Winston-Salem Journal*, Attn. Celebrations Editor, or return it to the *Winston-Salem Journal* lobby between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday–Friday. The form must be signed by one of the principals.
