Preliminary List of Judges Voluntarily Participating in the Governor's Flexible Furlough Plan

The following judges of the North Carolina General Court of Justice have agreed to a limited waiver of the protections of judicial salaries under Article IV Section 21 of the North Carolina Constitution, for the purpose of participating in the Governor's Flexible Furlough plan as announced and described for the months of May and June, 2009. The purpose of the waiver is to voluntarily participate in the same manner as other state employees not enjoying the same Constitutional protections. A number of judges have delayed a decision pending legislative action which would secure retirement rights, since this reduction would have an adverse effect on those whose retirements are imminent by reducing benefits for the rest of their lives. Several of those judges, who are listed in an appendix at the end of the list, have offered to contribute separately through other channels, but no mechanism for them to do so has yet been created.
