Your daily weather forecast is now in the A section. Find it every day on Page A6.

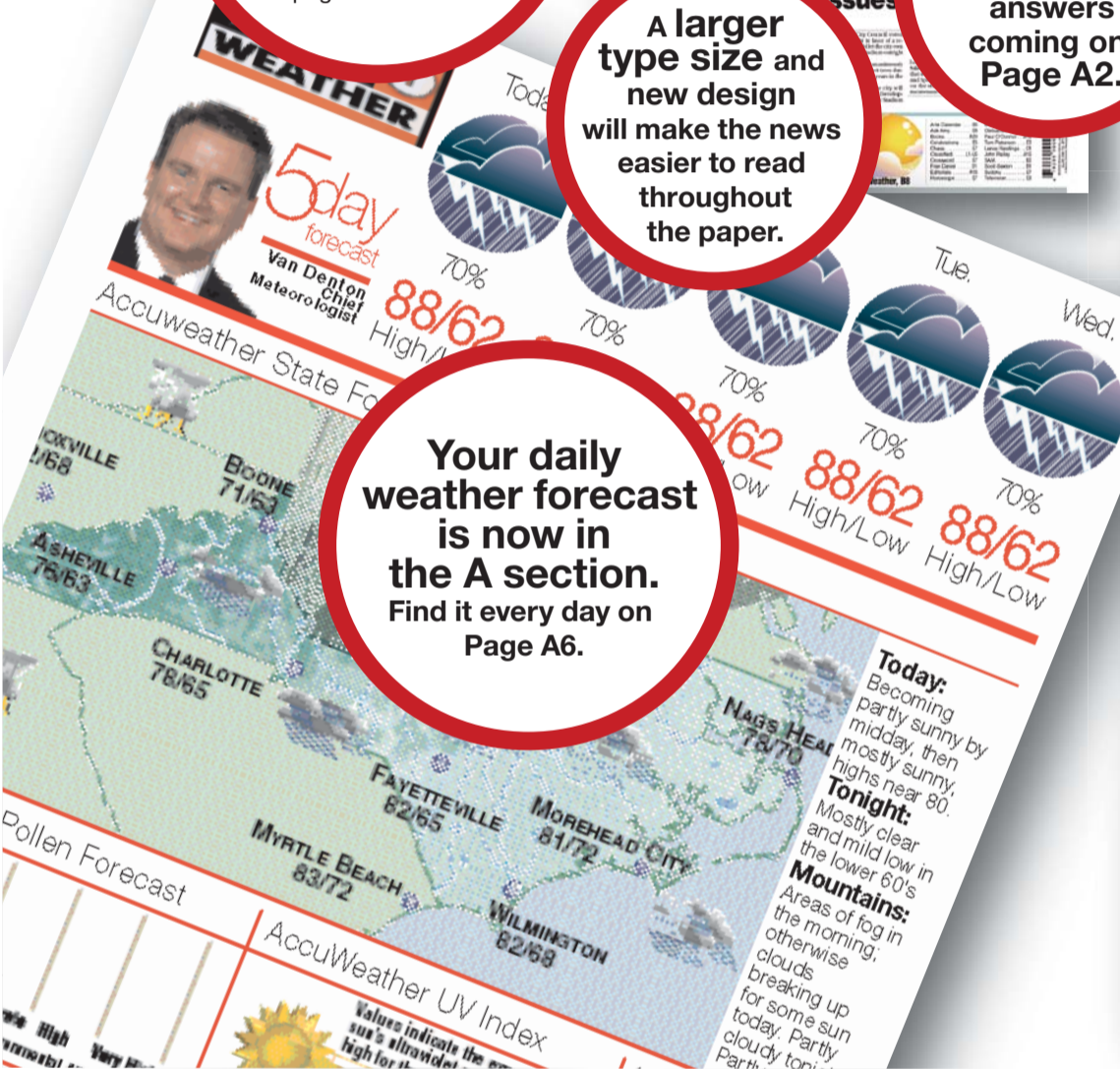
Our redesigned masthead will let you know where to find that day's leading national and sports news.
